

BRACELETS SIZE GUIDE

FIND YOUR PERFECT MATCH

The general rule for finding your bracelet size is to add 2 cm (0.8in) to your wrist size measurements. If you prefer a looser fit, you may wish to size up. You'll need: - Flexible measuring tape or ruler - string or strip of paper - Pen or marker.

Option 1: Use a flexible measuring tape With your palm open and facing up, wrap the measuring tape around your wrist, just above your wrist bone. Now note down the measurement of your wrist size.

Option 2: Use a string. With your palm open and facing up, wrap the string or strip of paper around your wrist, just above your wrist bone. Mark where the ends meet with a pen or marker. Now lay the string or piece of paper flat and measure it to where you've made the mark to find your wrist size and note it down.

Obs: For a solid hard gold bracelet (Willow bracelet) you will need to measure your hand with your thumb outstretched and aligned with your other fingers instead of doing it above your wrist bone to make sure the bracelet can come over your hand.
